

THE NAMES OF GOD IN RELATIONSHIP TO THE TRINITY

Genesis 1:1 (KJV)

In the beginning **God** created the heaven and the earth.

God - elohiym, *el-o-heem'*; plural of Hebrew 433 ('elowahh); of the supreme *God*; occasionally (very) great, judges, × mighty. Used 2,750 times referencing God.

Genesis 14:18 (KJV) And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the **Most High God**.

Here, God is 'el, *ale*; shortened from Hebrew 352 ('ayil); *strength*; as adjective *mighty*; especially the *Almighty* God, might (-y one), power, strong. Compounds are as follows:

Elyon: The strongest strong One: Genesis 14:17-20

El-Roi: The strong One who sees: Genesis 16:13

El-Shaddai: The breasted One: Genesis 17:1, Psalm 91:1

El-Olam: The everlasting God: Isaiah 40:28–31

Genesis 2:22 (NIV) Then the **Lord God** made a woman from the rib he had taken out of the man, and he brought her to the man.

Lord - Y^ehovah, *yeh-ho-vaw'*; from Hebrew 1961 (hayah); (the) self-*Existent* or *Eternal*; *Jehovah*, Jewish national name of God:- Jehovah, the Lord. Used 6,823 times to reference the Lord. In Gen. 2:22, it would read: “Then **Y^ehovah- elohiym** made a women...”

Y^ehovah / Jehovah has some compound names:

Jehovah Jireh: The Lord will provide: Genesis 22:13, 14

Jehovah Nissi: The Lord, my Banner: Exodus 17:15

Jehovah Shalom: The Lord is peace: Judges 6:24

Jehovah Rapha: The Lord is my Healer: Exodus 15:26

Jehovah Shammah: The Lord is present: Ezekiel 48:35

Jehovah Tsidkenu: The Lord of righteousness: Jerimiah 23:6

Jehovah Rohi (Raah): The Lord is my Shepherd: Psalm 23:1

Genesis 28:3 (NIV) May God **Almighty** bless you and make you fruitful and increase your numbers until you become a community of peoples.

Shadday, *shad-dah'ee*; from Hebrew 7703 (shadad); the *Almighty* :- Almighty.

Adonai: Master, Lord, the God who owns the Creation: Malachi 1:6

Adonai was spoken by the Hebrew people instead of the name **Y^ehovah / Jehovah** that was too sacred to speak.

Philippians 2:9-11 (NIV)

⁹Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name,

¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,

¹¹ and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
